## Preparing for Your Pick-Up

At Found in Faith Ministries, we strive to make your donation experience as smooth as possible. Here are just a few tips on how you can help us do that!

1. Clear any obstructions from the pathway to move furniture (ex. protruding artwork, furniture items not being donated, knick-knacks, etc.)
2. Disassemble furniture as needed and make sure necessary parts such as nuts and bolts are bagged and attached (ex. bedframe/headboard, bunkbed, legs from large table, etc.)
3. Empty contents from furniture prior to your scheduled pick-up time (ex. clothes in dresser, remote or VCR from tv stand, etc.)
4. Bag and label linen donations prior to our arrival
5. Contain pets in an area that is away from where volunteers will be working
6. Please call 443-519-2464 opt. 3 at least 24 hours in advance for all cancellation requests.

To protect those in need of our services, our volunteers have the right to refuse any items found to be in poor condition such as being heavily soiled, having rips/tears, having an offensive odor or are non-functioning. Items may also be refused if they are not easily accessible and/or volunteers deem the items retrieval to be unsafe.
